

Help for Sessional GPs - Appraisal and Revalidation - from BGPERT

Membership of Bath General Practice Educational Research Trust (BGPERT) entitles you to attend all of BGPERTs meetings. We have over fifty evening educational meetings arranged throughout the year in various parts of the BCAP area and an annual average of eighteen half and full day meetings every year, based on your learning needs from appraisal. Do visit our website www.bathgped.org which contains details of upcoming events as well as presentations from meetings we have held and useful links.

We can help make preparing for appraisal less of a burden, following the new GMC domains:

1. Knowledge, skills and performance

- We run a regular and varied program of daytime and evening accredited educational meetings. These can help you gain learning credits towards revalidation (attending meetings can earn GPs up to 20 of the required 50 credits per year)
- We also provide reflective practice forms (to help show what you have learned, how you have learned it and how it is relevant to your practice)
- We will provide you with a certificate for your appraisal recording all our accredited events that you have attended
- We run regular CPR updates, Communication Skills and Child Protection Updates as well as Medicines Management Meetings
- We can put you in touch with others locally who wish to be part of Self Directed Learning Groups

2. Safety and quality

- We run bimonthly Reflective Practice Meetings specifically aimed at SGPs, these are facilitated by a BANES Appraiser and provide an accredited opportunity to discuss and reflect upon your own and others SEAs as well as get updated on the latest changes to the appraisal process within the area
- It can also provide an opportunity to confidentially discuss and reflect upon any personal complaints, audits or interesting clinical cases that you may have been involved in, with peers, in a supportive and confidential environment

3. Communication, partnership and teamwork

- For revalidation purposes, GPs are required to complete 2 personal patient feedbacks over 5 years, or 1 patient feedback and 1 communication skills session
- In response to popular demand, we have managed to find a patient survey suitable for SGPs, based on the well used GPAQ, (General Practice Assessment Questionnaire) but simplified and streamlined. A copy is attached to the SGP page of our website

4. Maintaining Trust

- There is always time, at all meetings to discuss any professional issues you may have with colleagues or patients and issues of probity.
